There are general hazards associated with any areas and the main ones have been identified and detailed below.

Uneven surfaces	Trips, falls, cuts, grazes, bruises	All	3- 3	Leaders / Teachers responsible for supervision and instruction
Disorientation	Participants become lost, participants enter out of bound areas	All	3- 4	Leaders / Teachers responsible for supervision Boundary signage located around perimeter. Centre emergency producers in place for missing persons
Forest and vegetation areas	Cuts, grazes, rashes	All	3 - 3	Leaders / Teachers responsible for supervision and instruction
Adverse weather conditions	Exposure, chills	All	3 - 3	Leaders / Teachers responsible for supervision and instruction
Vehicle's on site	Hit by vehicle	All	3 - 3	Vehicles restricted / Barrier in place at entrance Speed limit 5mph imposed Centre staff to stop vehicle entering centre if not following rules.
Fire	Death	ALL	4 - 1	Fire precautions in place, instruction in specific locations, information provided to Leaders / teachers on arrival, Fire drills carried out, equipment checks in place. (See specific areas fire risk assessments) Centre patrols carried out during high drought times. Fire warning signs at main site entrance. Open fires banned during high temps
Theft from tents	Loss of property	All	4 - 4	CCTV in operation around 60% of the centre. Centre staff observations while working around centre. Customers advised not to bring valuables to centre during camp. Centre offer site safe for large amount of money needing to be stored for groups.

WALESBY FOREST RISK ASSESSMENT

High Winds	Loss of property	Campers	3 - 3	Customers advised of high winds if due, notices to be put in shop and local area. Centre marquees to be checked and taken down if needed to protect life and equipment.
Flooding due to heavy rain	Damage to property	Campers	3 - 3	Customers advised of heavy rain if due, notices to be put in shop and local area. Customers moved if centre manager sees they are in a place of risk. Emergency accommodation offered if campers need a bed for the night due to flooding
